## Faculty of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences

### Proposal to Change the Status of the Final Year Dissertation to Optional on the LLB Programmes

In November 2014, Senate approved the recommendation for a compulsory dissertation/project module for all UG programmes at Ulster. Following the recent change at Senate that ASQEC should consider all departures from this policy, this paper sets out a proposal for the Law dissertation at the both the Magee and the Jordanstown campuses to be optional.

Before the compulsory dissertation/project rule was introduced by Senate, the dissertation in Law was compulsory in Magee and optional in Jordanstown; all dissertations were made compulsory during the revalidation process in 2016/2017.

The proposal is to change the status of the dissertation modules above from compulsory to optional. There is no other structural change proposed to the degree programmes. Appended to this paper is the current status of all law modules at both campuses, and the programme level learning outcomes met by each module. The proposal to change the status of the dissertation module from compulsory to optional will not impact upon any student's ability to meet all programme level learning outcomes, as these can be met by a range of modules at levels 5 and 6 that contribute to the final award on all law programmes (single honours and modular), no matter which module combination is chosen.

The case for the proposal is set out below.

#### The Case for an Optional Dissertation within Law

Law students are expected to undertake research and be conversant with various sources, legal or otherwise at all levels on their degree programme. At both Jordanstown and Magee a number of assignments or projects are set over the course of the degree which enable a student to demonstrate ability to use primary sources and to undertake legal research. It is proposed that at both Magee and Jordanstown students should have the choice to undertake a dissertation in their final year rather than the current compulsory dissertation.

The new optional modules are relevant to practice based learning/employability, whilst retaining the dissertation/project element of the degree as an optional module. It should be noted that the QAA

Qualifications Framework does not stipulate that a bachelor's degree must have a compulsory dissertation/project; however, the following are stipulated as requirements:

- 4.15.1 Holders of a bachelor's degree with honours will have developed an understanding of a complex body of knowledge, some of it at the current boundaries of an academic discipline. Through this, the holder will have developed analytical techniques and problem-solving skills that can be applied in many types of employment. The holder of such a qualification will be able to evaluate evidence, arguments and assumptions, to reach sound judgements and to communicate them effectively.<sup>1</sup>
- 4.15.2 Holders of a bachelor's degree with honours should have the qualities needed for employment in situations requiring the exercise of personal responsibility, and decision-making in complex and unpredictable circumstances<sup>2</sup>

The Law School supports the case for an optional dissertation with the following evidence:

- The QAA benchmark statement for Law does not require the inclusion of a dissertation nor does the Law Society require it for professional recognition.
- Students undertake research and are conversant with various sources at all levels on their degree programme. Students at all levels have considerable expertise of legal research and writing through the various forms of assessment employed particularly in final year. Further, the general intellectual skills of analysis, synthesis, critical judgment and evaluation are demonstrated pervasively through the programmes, particularly in the second and final years (level 5/level 6 modules).
- Many law graduates pursue a career in the legal profession and staff considered that a range of optional modules such as Family Law; Medical Law; Employment Law; Business and Commercial law and Company Law, among others, enhanced individual employability prospects rather than a dissertation that limits options for student choice and specialism in final year. The proposal therefore enables and promotes employability and progression to higher level awards, particularly the Access to Justice LLM.
- Students and the External Examiner support the proposed variation to the policy. The student voice is overwhelmingly in support of making the dissertation optional. In a vote taken by the current second years (Sing Hons and Law Major), who are about to be imminently affected by a compulsory dissertation in the next academic year, ALL the students in attendance voted in favour of an optional dissertation. This is supported in principle by the External Examiners to the degree.
- By keeping the dissertation compulsory, we automatically diminish the opportunity to maintain the current suite of electives in final year as only a few of the electives will run. The current electives reflect staff research interests and give students the opportunity to specialize in a variety of fields relevant for practice or employment in a range of areas.
- A compulsory dissertation reduces the choice students have in final year and for the LLB Major (approximately half our intake) students the result is that they only be able to choose 1 Law elective. They are required to undertake 2 minor modules and 3 core Law modules

including the Dissertation (whilst Equity and Evidence are deemed to be optional, a change made in the last revalidation in 2016, they are in reality compulsory as are core for QLD status and entry into the legal profession).

- Keeping the dissertation compulsory is detrimental to the introduction of new electives such as the Law Clinic module

For all of these reasons, the Law School requests that ASQEC supports the case for an optional dissertation on both the Single Honours and the Major LLB programmes at both the Jordanstown and Magee campuses.
