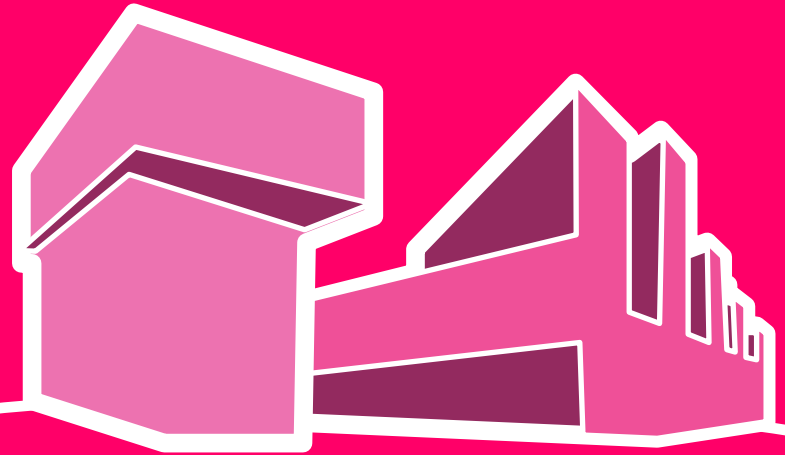

Active Learning





Teacher

Active learning puts students at the centre of their learning through participation in activities linked to their learning outcomes.

Environment

A flexible space works best for this, where students can move the furniture and split into groups to collaborate on set activities. Students may want to break out into social spaces for activities.

Technology

Although not essential, a room with projector and good Wifi would be beneficial. Office 365 could be used for student collaboration.

Environment

Students should feel free to adjust the environment to suit how they want to learn. Social spaces could also be used, but the lecturer should be informed and students should return once finished for discussion.
