



## The Liam Kelly Scholarships in Law

### Terms & Conditions

Applications will be accepted from part-time students who have completed the first year of their course at Ulster University. Applicants must meet the University's criteria for both of the following:

- To be classed as a mature student (21-years or over);
- To be recognised as coming from a disadvantaged socioeconomic background.

The application and selection process will be administered by the School of Law. The selection criteria are as follows:

- Academic excellence;
- Demonstration of a commitment to their studies;
- Description of how the scholarship will potentially impact on their studies and on their chosen career path.

Shortlisted applicants may be invited to attend a selection panel meeting for interview.

Each scholarship is valued at a total amount of £4,500. Payment will be provided to the scholar as follows once the School of Law has confirmed that he or she is completing their studies on time and is in good academic standing:

For part-time undergraduate students:

- £1,500 paid immediately upon enrolment for 2<sup>nd</sup> year;
- £1,000 paid at the start of 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> year.

For part-time postgraduate students:

- £2,500 paid immediately upon enrolment for 2<sup>nd</sup> year;
- £2,000 at a mid-way point in 2<sup>nd</sup> year.

In the event that a scholar is unable to complete his or her studies on time, or is no longer in good academic standing, and has not provided any extenuating circumstances to the School of Law, the University reserves the right to withdraw the remaining Scholarship funding from the scholar.

Scholars may be required to participate in promotional activities related to the Scholarship, for example, to appear in photographs taken at prize ceremonies and to provide quotations for use in material related to the Scholarship.

In October of each academic year, the School of Law will provide a brief annual report to the donor regarding the scholar's academic progress.

- be in receipt of benefits which may include state income support, working tax credit or child tax credit\*;
- an individual income of less than £16,190 gross\*

\*Each applicant must provide evidence of eligibility. Please supply a photocopy of your payslip, income support and/or tax credit documents with this application.
