...but this will go back to normal

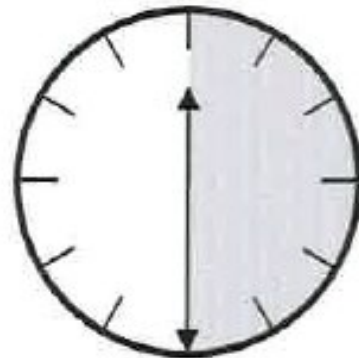
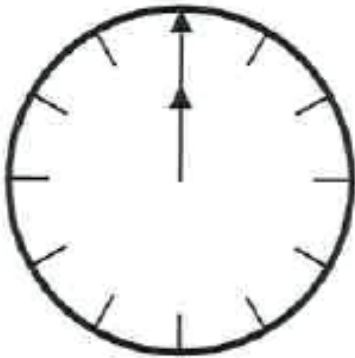
In the morning, the children's stepmother told them that the whole family was going into the forest to collect firewood.
