The Postgraduate Research Experience Survey

PRES is a global survey with 50,600 respondents in 2019, achieving a 42% response rate. 107 institutions were involved in the survey.

Key to figures:	
Highest quarter	In the highest quarter of institutions globally - top 25%
Second quarter	In the second quarter of institutions - above 50% but below the top 25%
Third quarter	In the third quarter of institutions - below 50% but above the bottom 25%
Lowest quarter	In the lowest quarter of institutions globally - bottom 25%

Ranking and quarter methodology

The quarters and ranking are based on all institutions that have, on average, 23 valid responses or over to the questions making up the survey area. Ranking and quarters are only reported when there are a minimum of 8 institutions within an area.

Where a ranking or quarter position is starred (*) then it is significantly different from the average (mean score), for that breakdown. This indicates that there is less than 5% chance it is a random difference.
