# Enquiry-Based Learning

A student centred approach to learning and teaching which has an emphasis on group work and uses information sources such as the library and the worldwide web .

Typically it can be split into three subsections:

## Problem-based Learning

Is an exploration of scenario driven learning experience. They are often single subject based, authentic, are short in duration, have set steps and solutions are provided and discussed.

## Small Scale Investigations

Often based around field work or case studies that have been adapted to disciplinary contexts.

## Project-based Learning

This includes projects which can be live in collaboration with industry or indeed research projects. This method encourages a research-based approach to projects and processes. Often multi-disciplinary by nature, tend to be longer in duration (days/weeks), have general steps, goals and usual output a product, practice or service. *Adapted from: <http://www.ceeb1.manchester.ac.uk/eb1/>*
