

## Student Remote Access Service (SRAS)

Azure SRAS provides access to dedicated School laboratory facilities and services including access to local applications, printers, internal web pages and your own documents. It enables 24/7 access to laboratory endpoints from any internet connection from your own computer.

It effectively mimics an on-premise laboratory experience from your own device with access to all module specific applications without the requirement to install the applications on your own device.

The system is easy to use, works on all main operating systems and is accessed via your Web browser. We provide access to the vast majority of Faculty specific applications through SRAS.

Because SRAS is brokering access to remotely installed applications via the University's infrastructure, depending on your Internet connection speed and stability, the applications on SRAS may run more slowly than applications that you have on your computer.

Access to School IT Laboratory services is authorised and managed at a local level from within individual Schools.
