Importing favourites from Internet Explorer to Microsoft Edge

Copying bookmarks from other browsers into Microsoft Edge does not remove the favourites from the source browser (Internet Explorer), nor does it interfere with your existing favourites in Edge. To import favourites to Edge:

1. Open Edge on your computer and tap the three-dot menu (...) at the top right corner of the browser.



2. Select 'Settings'.



3. Select the 'Import browser data'.
