

# How to increase your citations

1. Have an ORCID and use it.
2. Co-author with international author(s).
3. Cite yourself, and the work of other Ulster colleagues, where appropriate.
4. Ensure the journal you are publishing in is indexed in Scopus.
5. Publish in the top ranking journals in your subject.
6. Ensure your work is Open Access.
7. Use your free author prints / e-copies.
8. Promote your publications on social media and on research discovery sites.
9. Know what your h-index is and promote your output that will increase your h-index.
