

## Eduroam Android Configuration instructions

1. Click "Settings" then select "Wireless & Networks" and then; "Wi-Fi settings".
2. If Wi-Fi is not enabled, choose "Wi-Fi" to enable it.
3. Select "eduroam".
4. You may now be asked for a password to protect the credential storage on your device. This is a security setting for your device and not your wi-fi password. Please enter a memorable password here to continue.
5. For "EAP method" select "PEAP".
6. For "Phase 2 authentication" select "MSCHAPV2".
7. If you are using the **Nougat (7) OS** on your Android, set  
"CA Certificate" to "Use system certificates" and  
"Domain" to "ulster.ac.uk".  
  
If you are using the **Oreo (8) OS** or **Pie (9) OS** set  
"CA Certificate" to "Do not validate".
8. Enter your Identity as your username  
**Username:** Your University email address  
Some devices may have an "Anonymous identity" field. Leave this blank.
9. Enter your password.  
**Password:** Your University network password
10. Touch "Connect".
11. Your device should show "Obtaining IP address from eduroam..." then shortly after "Connected to eduroam".
12. **IMPORTANT: Press "Cancel" to go back to the previous screen. Do NOT press "Forget" or you will need to enter all the configuration information again.**

Your device should now connect automatically to the eduroam wireless network whenever it is in range.
