

# **Installing Panopto...**

Panopto can be installed for Windows from the Software Centre, or for a Mac it can be installed through the Self-Service portal.






If you do not require Blackboard integration, you can now open Panopto as standalone software.


# **Using Panopto with Blackboard...**



# **Your Lecture Capture Session...**

Once you are satisfied with all your sources / inputs, and ready to begin Lecture Capture, press the record button. You can now present your session.






When you have completed your lecture capture session, press the stop button. You can also pause the session at any time.

At this point Panopto will show folder your session will be saved in.


You can also choose to name the session, and add a description.

Then press upload to complete the process.




Once Panopto have prepared your Lecture Capture file, you will receive an e-mail notification.


Your Lecture capture session will then be available to edit and share.




# **Edit your Lecture Capture Session...**

You can now use the edit tools within Panopto to makes changes to your session;






