WHO AND WHY?

Speak to your Line Manager to discuss why you need the time off and the likely duration.

* Leave is granted for consecutive working days on a pro rata basis.

Emergency Special Leave

For all employees who require time off to deal with an unexpected emergency situation.



BEREAVEMENT LEAVE

BEREAVED	NO. OF DAYS LEAVE*
Child, partner, spouse, parent	Up to 10 days
Sibling, grandparent/child, immediate in-law/stepfamily	Up to 5 days
Extended family member (Aunt, Uncle, Niece, Nephew)	1 day
Miscarriage (24 weeks and under)	Up to 3 days

COMPASSIONATE AND EMERGENCY LEAVE

Up to 5 days paid leave in a leave year – to deal with an emergency involving a dependant or someone you have caring responsibilities for.

CARER'S LEAVE

Covered under Compassionate and Emergency Leave.

- Do you need adjustments? e.g. flexible working.
- You are advised to try to book appointments for the start or end of working day.



DOMESTIC CRISIS LEAVE

1 day paid leave in a leave year

- to deal with domestic emergencies such as fire, flood, burglary, etc.
