Establishment of Award	As a result of a donation by the Northern Ireland Division of Business and Professional Women Limited (BPW NI).
Basis of Award	<p>The scholarship is intended to provide the holder with the opportunity to travel and visit places outside Northern Ireland, which will allow the student to extend her experience in ways which are likely to enrich her personal and academic skills.</p> <p>The scholarship shall normally be tenable for a period during the following summer vacation, and the programme of travel shall be agreed and approved by the selection panel. A scholar is liable to forfeit her scholarship should she fail without good reason to carry out the terms of the approved programme of travel.</p>
