CA3 forms were submitted (8.5.12) to introduce Exit Awards of Certificate in Higher Education (CertHE) and Associate Bachelors (AB) for both the BSc Hons Food and Nutrition and BSc Hons Human Nutrition.

The AB award for both programmes has now been approved following written receipt of External Examiner endorsement.

The Course team made a special case not to have "Food and Nutrition" or "Human Nutrition" respectively in the title of the proposed CertHE in a submission to the Teaching and Learning Committee on the 17th October 2012 (Paper No TLC/12/34c). In response to the submission the Teaching and Learning Committee considered the proposed title was not entirely appropriate and asked the Faculty to reflect further on the appropriate title and bring a revised proposal to the next meeting.

In response to this the Course team, following discussion with the External Examiners of both Courses, propose, with the endorsement of the External Examiners, the title for the CertHE for both BSc Hons Food and Nutrition and BSc Hons Human Nutrition to be "**CertHE in Science for Nutrition**".

We trust that the Teaching and Learning Committee will be able to permit us to use the proposed title for these awards.
